Hosted on Leger's online OmniWeb platform, using Leger's Computer Aided Web Interviewing software (CAWI).



Conducted June 8-12, 2018



999 Alberta residents aged 18 years of age or older, were surveyed online using Leger's online panel, Legerweb.com



The data have been weighted by age, gender and region to ensure representativeness



As a non-random internet survey, a margin of error is not reported (margin of error accounts for sampling error). Had these data been collected using a probability sample, the margin of error for a sample size of 999 Albertans, aged 18 years or older, would be ± 4.4 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.







Detailed Methodology

Sample Plan

The selection of participants was done randomly from the LegerWeb online panel.

Léger owns and operates an Internet panel that includes more than 400,000 Canadians from coast to coast. An online panel consists of web users profiled according to different socio-demographic variables. The majority of the Léger panel members (60%) were randomly recruited by telephone over the past ten years, making it highly similar to the current Canadian population for many demographic characteristics. In addition, 35% of panelists were recruited through affiliate programs, and 5% through campaigns and partner programs.

To be eligible, respondents must be 18 years of age and be eligible to vote in Alberta.

Weighted and unweighted samples

The table below shows the regional distribution of respondents, before and after weighting. There was a slight imbalance in the regional distribution in the unweighted sample. The weighting process mainly helped to adjust the weight of regions outside major centers, which was slightly overrepresented in the sample.
