

Methodology



Method

An online survey among 1, 296 American respondents 18 years of age or older. Out of those, 857 watched the Debate.

Respondents were randomly recruited using LEO's online panel.



When

September 10th to September 11th, 2024.



Margin of error

For comparison purposes, a probability sample of this size yields a margin of error no greater than ±2.72%, (19 times out of 20).



Weighting

Results were weighted according to age, gender, region, education, race, number of people in the household, in order to ensure a representative sample of the American population.



Methodology



Significant differences

Data in bold **red** characters indicate a significantly lower proportion than that of other respondents. Conversely, data in bold **green** characters indicate a significantly higher proportion than that of other respondents.



Rounded data

The numbers presented have been rounded up. However, the numbers before rounding were used to calculate the sums presented and might therefore not correspond to the manual addition of these numbers.



Base: All respondents (n=1,296)












