SCOPE


 A total of 2,226 surveys were completed with Canadians over the age of 18. The margin of error for a sample of this size is +/- 2.1%, 19 times out of 20.


Country Divided on Coalition or Election


Eastern Canada Prefers Coalition, Western Election


Canadians Not Comfortable with Governor General Making Decision



How comfortable are you with the governor general, a non-elected appointee, being the one to decide who will lead the country?




Alberta, Prairies and Quebec Most Uncomfortable



How comfortable are you with the governor general, a non-elected appointee, being the one to decide who will lead the country?




Half think Harper Should Step Down if Conservatives Defeated



If the Conservative government is defeated in the House of Commons, should Stephen Harper resign as Conservative leader?




Eastern Canada Thinks Harper Should Step Down



If the Conservative government is defeated in the House of Commons, should Stephen Harper resign as Conservative leader?




Concern Over Separatist Party Holding Balance of Power



How concerned are you that a separatist party may hold the balance of power as part of a coalition government?




Quebec the Only Region Not Concerned
