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# METHODOLOGY



<b></b>	METHOD	A web survey was conducted among 1,591 Canadians 18 years of age or older and eligible to vote in Canada. An oversample of 604 respondents from the province of Quebec was surveyed. Respondents had the option of completing the survey in English or in French and were randomly recruited using LEO's online panel.

	MARGIN OF ERROR	No margin of error can be associated with a non-probability sample (Web panel in this case). However, for comparative purposes, a probability sample of 1,591 respondents would have a margin of error of $\pm 2.5\%$ , 19 times out of 20.
	WEIGHTING	Results were weighted according to <b>gender, age, mother tongue, region, education and</b> <b>presence of children in the household</b> in order to ensure a representative sample of the Canadian population.
	SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENCES	In this report, data in bold <b>red</b> characters indicate a significantly lower proportion than that of other respondents. Conversely, data in bold <b>green</b> characters indicate a significantly higher proportion that that of other respondents.

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




# Leger **EVOLUTION OF VOTING INTENTIONS IN CANADA**










