## Methodology



Method
Online survey
among respondents 18 years of age or older.
(Canadian sample: $n=1,529$ ).
Respondents had the option of completing the surveyin English or in French and were randomly recruited using LEO's online panel.

## Margin of error

For comparison purposes, a probability sample of this size yields a margin of error no greater than $\pm 2.5 \%$, (19 times out of 20) for the Canadian sample.


Weighting
Results were weighted according to age, gender, mother tongue, region, education and presence of children in the household in order to ensure a representative sample of the Canadian population.

## Rounded data

## Methodology

Leger is the polling firm that has presented the most accurate election survey data, on average, over the last ten years in Canada. During the last federal election in 2021, Leger was once again the most accurate firm in the country. This accuracy is attributed to the quality of the LEO panel and rigorous application of methodological rules by Leger's 600 employees, including 200 professionals in Leger's eight offices across Canada (Montreal, Toronto, Quebec City, Winnipeg, Calgary, Edmonton and Vancouver) and in the United States (New York).

Poll aggregator 338Canada.com gave Leger the highest rating among all polling firms in Canada for the accuracy of its studies.

## Key Highlights (1/2)

From May 31 to June 2, 2024, we surveyed Canadians to find out their opinions and perceptions on the conflicts currently taking place in the world, more specifically about the Middle East conflict and the conflict between Ukraine and Russia.

## Some of the key highlights of our survey on regional conflicts include...

- Half of Canadians (49\%) follow the conflict in the Middle East very or somewhat dosely, while $48 \%$ do not follow the current conflict. This represents a decrease of 14 points in Canadians following the conflict since October 2023.
- A quarter of Canadians ( $23 \%$ ) think the media coverage of the conflict is more favourable toward Palestinians, and $17 \%$ think it is more fa vourable toward Israel. Around a quarter (22\%) thinkit has been generally balanced, and more than a third (38\%) don't know.
- One in ten Canadians (12\%) think Canada is not supportive enough of Israel, while $23 \%$ think the support is about right, and $26 \%$ think that Canada is too supportive of Is rael. Four Canadians out of ten (39\%) have no opinion on the matter. Since October 2023, there has been an increase of 10 points in Canadians thinking that the government is too supportive of Israel.
- One in five Canadians (21\%) think Canada is not supportive enough of the Palestinian people. In contrast, $23 \%$ think the support is about right, and $17 \%$ think that Canada is too supportive of the Palestinian people. Four Canadians out of ten ( $40 \%$ ) have no opinion on the matter.
- Half of Canadians (46\%) think that lasting peace between Israelis and Palestinians cannot be reached. This represents a decrease of 5 points since October 2023.
- $45 \%$ of Canadians agree that Is rael is committing genocide in the Gaza Strip, while $23 \%$ disagree, and $32 \%$ don't know. Compared to October 2023, fewer Canadians disagree that Is rael is committing genocide ( $23 \%$ vs $31 \%$ in 2023) , and more Canadians can't form an opinion on the matter ( $32 \%$ vs $26 \%$ in 2023).


## Key Highlights (2/2)

- More than one-third of Canadians (39\%) follow very or somewhat dosely the conflict going on in Ukraine, while $56 \%$ do not follow the current conflict.
- More than half of Canadians (54\%) think they have a good understanding of the conflict between Ukraine and Russia, while $38 \%$ have a poor understanding.
- One-fifth of Canadians (18\%) think Canada is not supportive enough of Ukraine, while $39 \%$ think the support is about right, and $16 \%$ think that Canada is too supportive of Ukraine. One-quarter of Canadians (26\%) have no opinion on the matter.
- Nearly one-third of Canadians (30\%) think that lasting peace between Ukraine and Russia can be reached, while $40 \%$ think the opposite, and $30 \%$ don't know.
